Message from Treasurer – Tom Culverwell

Weekend Expenses: Did you realize that it costs Sonshine North approximately \$6,500 to put on each set of weekends? This includes the cost to Marywood Retreat Center for Camp St. Johns, as well as food, liability insurance, and other incidentals. Of course the purpose of each weekend is to help build our personal relationship with Jesus Christ, but we can't do it without the funds.

Annual Expenses: In addition to the cost of each set of weekends, Sonshine North has continuing annual expenses that must be met. Just a few of these include liability insurance to cover Sonshine North for the rest of our activities, annual dues to the National Secretariat, preparing team books, music licenses, consumable supplies, and other incidentals. For the 2007 year these expenses were more than \$7,000.

What I'm leading up to is that Sonshine North is now enrolled in a program called Simply Giving, that gives each and every one of us the ability to make direct contributions to Sonshine North.
